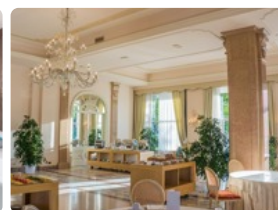
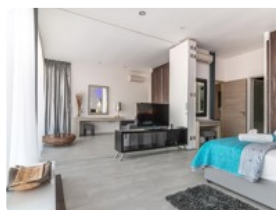
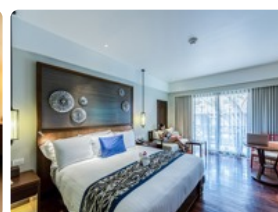
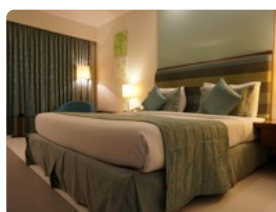
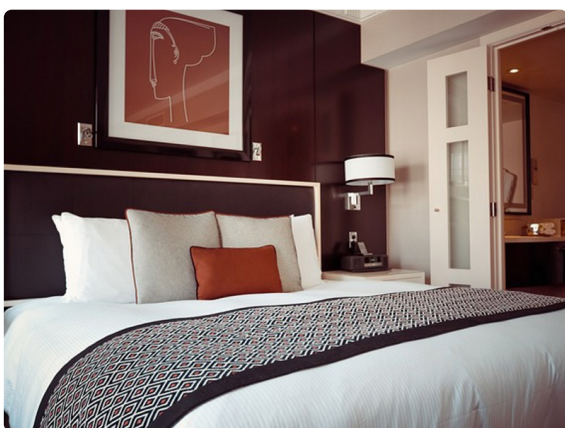
You can tip your driver - Rands are preferred. You can visit the ATM at the airport before departing if you should want to tip the driver.
